This Vision Document will be discussed and adapted by the PCC. It continues the journey that we began in 2018 and sets the direction of travel for the next year under God's guidance.

We believe in Sharing the Love of Jesus...

God's love, like a river, flows towards us, in us and through us. The Celts like St. Werburga recognised the significance of rivers in community. They based their houses of prayer (mynsters) at the intersection of rivers. A mynster was built here in Trentham in the second half of the 7th century and is the spiritual roots of our church.

The river of life is a constant theme in the Bible; in Genesis pouring out in creation and watering the garden of Eden, in Ezekiel's vision flowing from the temple out into the desert bringing life wherever it went. It is seen as a blessing to all who are near it and entering the deep roots of nearby trees it produces leaves and fruit for the healing of the nations. (See Genesis 2 Ezekiel 47 and Revelation 22).

Trentham church was planted by a river to share the love of Jesus. It was a place of hospitality and refreshment, prayer and healing, learning and discipleship. We build on these foundations today and long for the deep wells of God's love and mercy to flow through our lives, church, community and beyond.

Over recent centuries, Trentham with its gardens and lake have represented a place of refreshment and retreat to the city and beyond. We believe God is calling us to make the invitation to those who will hear...

'Come to the river and rest from the wounds of life, so you may return refreshed to live for Christ'

The world's greatest need is love and the Bible tells us that 'God is Love' (1 John 4:8) So let us commit to placing ourselves in the river of God's love, being filled with His Spirit so that we might overflow His Love in the world.
